Community Hospital Moves Patients to NEW Hospital

Patients moved from 2021 N. 12th Street to NEW hospital at 2351 G Road.

Mesa County, CO - Community Hospital moved all inpatients from the old hospital at 2021 N. 12th Street to the NEW Community Hospital location at 2351 G Road this morning at 6am. Community Hospital worked with multiple local ambulance service agencies to move all patients via ambulance.

“We could not be more excited that this project has finally come to fruition,” said Chris Thomas, President and CEO for Community Hospital. “Countless people have worked tirelessly for so many years to make this dream a reality. This new state-of-the-art hospital will serve the health care needs of our community for decades to come.” added Thomas.

Community Hospital in Grand Junction, Colorado, is a full-service, acute-care hospital licensed for 78 beds. The new state-of-the-art hospital boasts over 140,000 square feet and features 44 private patient rooms, a new labor and delivery unit and a more robust emergency department. Additionally, Community Hospital is working to increase to a Level III trauma center in April.

Community Hospital broke ground on the new hospital in October 2014. The design of the new facility was under the direction of Gresham Smith and Partners and Boulder and Associates Architects of Boulder, Colorado. Shaw Construction of Grand Junction and Saunders Construction of Denver were selected to complete the \$50 million dollar project. Importantly, nearly 85% of all work that could be completed locally, was done by local subcontractors.

As part of the Colorado West Healthcare System, Community Hospital offers full outpatient diagnostic services and inpatient care for the Western Slope region of Colorado, and eastern Utah. Community Hospital brings together expert staff and world-class technology in a healing, family-centered environment.

Community Hospital worked with multiple local ambulance service agencies to move inpatients every 5-7 minutes from the old hospital to the new hospital at 2351 G Rd.
