Mesa County, Colo. -- On Saturday, August 13th, the Community Hospital Foundation will host the **28th Annual Tour of the Valley bike ride**. Cyclists who have enjoyed the Tour over the past 27 years know what spectacular cycling the Grand Valley offers. This year's ride will once again offer the ever-popular 100 mile route which takes riders over the Colorado National Monument with rest stops along the way. There are also 30, 55, and 75 mile route options available.

Cyclists will begin and end their ride at the new Community Hospital, located at 2351 G Road (just west of Canyon View Park). Check-in time is from 6-8:30 a.m. Registration fees are dependent on route selection.

There is also a pre-registration packet pick-up on Friday, August 12th at Candlewood Suites, located at 654 Market Street, GJ, CO 81505.

Proceeds from this year's event will go to support concussion education and prevention through health education and wellness activities offered free to the public by Community Hospital.
